


The registration number of a car is a way to recognize the car, to find it again, and every authority knows immediately which car it is. A similar identification is now also available for hazardous mixtures: the UFI code. In the event of a calamity, the composition of the mixture can be determined quickly and unambiguously, based on which appropriate measures can be immediately determined and taken by the poison control center.


A 16-part number/letter combination to identify the formulation. Mandatory on the packaging and voluntary on the SDS.

Mandatory from:

- Consumer use: 1-1-2021
- Professional use: 1-1-2021
- Industrial use: 1-1-2024


Transitional period until 1-1-2025 for mixtures that have already been notified before 1-1-2021.

Purpose of the UFI



- Rapid identification of hazardous mixtures in the event of an emergency.
- Identification of the formulation for the poison centers.

UFI generation




- A European VAT number or companycode
- Formulation number consists of max. 9 digits, between 0 and 268435255.

Generate yourself via ufi.echa.europa.eu/#/generate

Validity: When the composition of the mixture changes outside the permitted limits, a new UFI code is required.

Consequences of formula changes



- A new formulation number
- A new UFI code
- Label changes
- Administration of the UFI / formulation number
- A new PCN login.
